GENERAL INFORMATION

UNDERGRADUATE

Credentials needed for applicants depend on previous education experience and the planned major area of study at Southern University. All credentials must be submitted, along with the completed application (enclosed), prior to being accepted for admission to the university. Credentials must be received in the Office of the Registrar by the deadline for applying to the university.

New Transfers

Students desiring to transfer from regionally accredited colleges and universities to Southern University with less than 12 semester hours of course work must meet the same requirements as the first time freshman. Students with 12 hours or more must have a GPA of 2.0 (based on 4.0) on college level courses (non-developmental) on transfer work.

- Official college or university transcript(s) from each college or university attended
 - Transfer Reference Sheet signed by Dean of Students from last college or university attended
 - Copy of Immunization Record
 - Copy of Social Security Card (please let us know if you do not have a card.)
- Note: Transfer students applying for Financial Aid at southern University should submit a Student Financial Aid Transcript from the university attended.

Additional criteria for those transfer students who have not earned the Associate Degree or higher from an accredited institution:

- Students must be eligible to return to the institution from which they are transferring.
- Students desiring to transfer with the minimum GPA on college level courses, but less than the minimum college level hours earned, must also meet the freshmen admissions criteria in order to be admitted as transfer students.
- Students desiring admission as transfer students and in need of more than one developmental course will not be eligible for transfer to Southern University.

Transfer International

Transfer international students must have completed a recognized secondary program and meet transfer admission criteria. All international students applying for admission must arrange to have official transcripts sent directly to the Registrar's Office from all colleges

- International students for whom English is a second language are required to demonstrate English proficiency.
- All international students whose first language is not English and "who are applying?" for admission as undergraduate students must take the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL).
- A current notarized statement of financial support
- Transfer international students must have completed a recognized secondary program.
- A minimum TOEFL score of 500 paper or 173 computer or provide other documentation deemed acceptable by the institution to which the student is seeking admission.
- Transfer international students must meet transfer admission criteria.

Summer Only

Students applying for admission to the University for Study during summer only must submit:

- Letter of good standing from institution where currently enrolled (must reflect student status as of the end of the semester currently enrolled)
- Copy of Immunization Record
- Copy of social Security Card (Please let us know if you do not have a card.)

Mandatory Selective Service Registration Requirements for all Males from Ages 18 to 25 Years

The Southern University System does hereby adopt the following as its policy to comply with the provisions set forth in House Bill 1549 of the 1999 Regular Session of the Louisiana Legislature that mandates males from ages 18 to 25 years to register for the draft:

All males, from ages 18 to 25 years, who seek to enroll at any postsecondary institution in the Southern University system in a program of study on or after August 15, 1999 **MUST** provide to the Office of the Registrar or the Office of Admissions on their respective campuses, documented proof of their registration for the federal draft under the Military Selective Services Act. Any male within this age group who is not required to register with Selective Services must submit documented verification to the Office of Registrar or the Office of Admissions that he is not required to register for the draft.

Offices of the Registrar and Admissions must insure that their respective campuses are in compliance with this mandate. **All applications** for admission must be amended to include the following Statement of Compliance.

Statement of Compliance

The Selective Service Act and Louisiana Revised Statute 17:3151 (A) requires all males, 18 to 25 years old, to provide documentation that they are registered with Selective Services for the draft or to provide documents certifying that they are not required to register. For efficiency in administering and managing this policy, all students, males and females of any age, who are enrolled or seeking enrollment at a campus in the Southern University System must complete the compliance statement below. Please respond as applicable.

(No male of the age 18 to 25 or other students will be enrolled or certified as eligible to receive State or Federal financial assistance without this certification or one of the following certifications.
